Welcome Weekend Canvas Site

Many of your courses will use Canvas to share information, enable collaboration and discussion, and provide feedback critical to your growth as a scholar. Canvas is also a tool that you can use to complete several other required tasks as you step into your first semester at Notre Dame. While many of these items are already available for your completion, some are accessible only after a specific date. Return to this list regularly throughout the summer to access newly-launched items.

Have a major in mind? Let it guide you.

Prioritize registering for those courses that are required or recommended for your primary major. Explore these requirements and recommendations on the [Major Requirements page](#). Use the [Sample First-Year Student Schedules page](#) to view possible courses for your first and second semester at Notre Dame according to your intended program of study.

First-year, Core, and College Requirements

All Notre Dame students, regardless of major, must complete a certain number of course requirements to graduate. In your first year, you must complete the two-semester Moreau First-Year Seminar course, as well as the First-Year Writing Requirement: Writing and Rhetoric and University Seminar. Note that students with AP or IB credit may be exempt from taking Writing and Rhetoric. For more information on AP and IB credit requirements, visit the [Advanced Credit and Placement page](#).

In addition to those First-Year Requirements, all students must satisfy the requirements of the Core Curriculum, as well as those requirements specified by your College of study. You can familiarize yourself with these requirements by reviewing the [Core Curriculum](#) and [College Requirements](#) pages.

Explore second major, supplementary major, and minors

Once you have considered Major Requirements (major-specific course requirements and recommendations for the first year), the first-year requirements, and Core Curriculum requirements, you may wish to turn your attention to second majors, supplementary majors, or minors. While second majors and minors are not a requirement for graduation, many students pursue them as a complement to their major course of study. Note that some requirements for your second/supplementary major or minor might double-count as a Core or college requirement.
