Before Friday: Check your test scores

Confirm that your AP, IB HL Exam, or SAT II score have been received by accessing the "My Test Scores" app on [InsideND](#). (Search "My Test Scores" within the InsideND portal). If anything is missing, review the steps on the [AP Exam Credit](#) and [IB HL Exam Credit](#) pages.

To prepare for this first advising meeting, be sure to review all registration materials and familiarize yourself with course planning resources. It is also very helpful to come prepared with a list of questions!

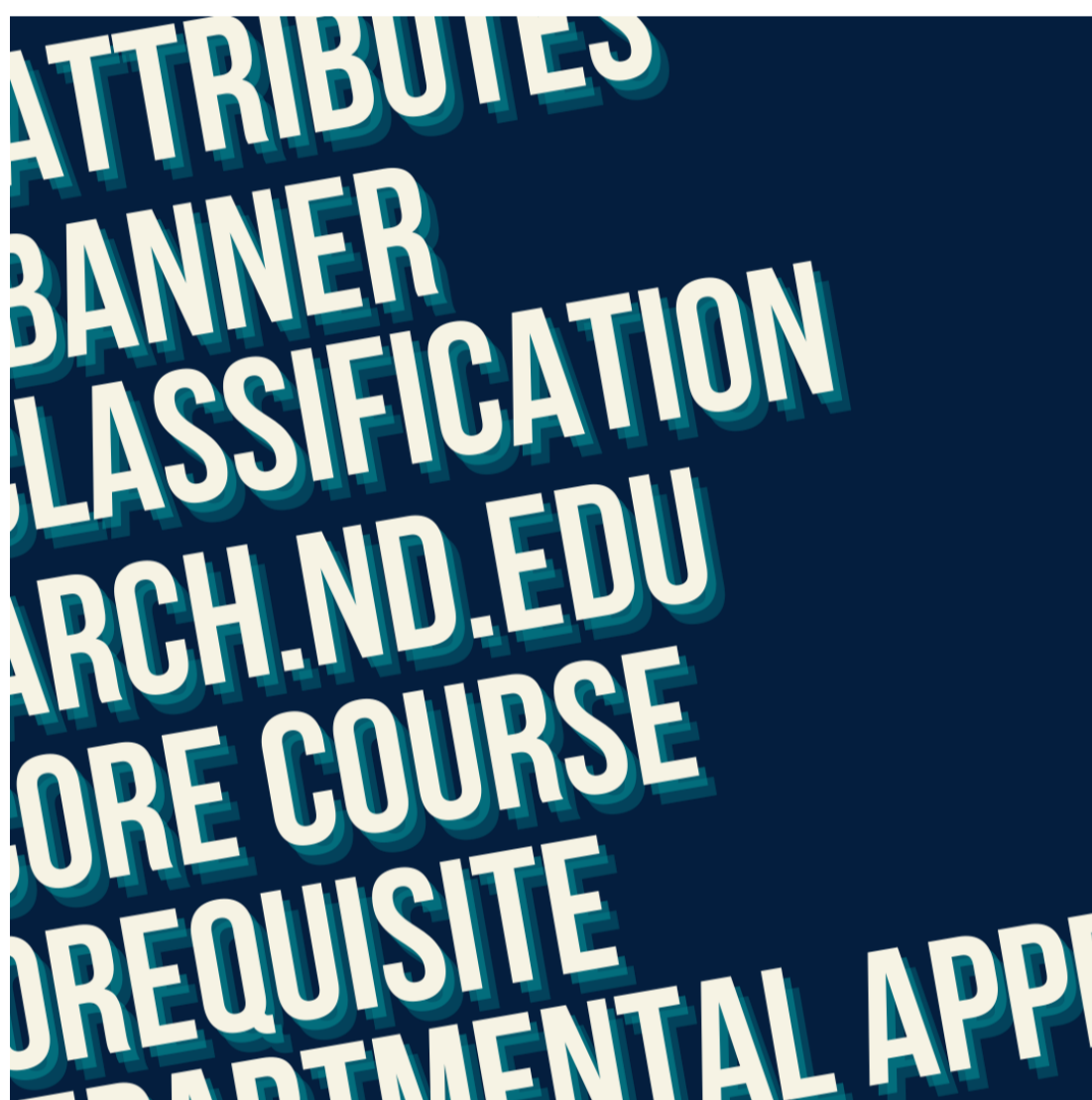
How to prepare to meet with your First Year Advisor

A Reminder on Registration Time Tickets

- All registration times are in Eastern Daylight Time, **not your local time**
- Registration time tickets are randomly assigned.
- You will have access to NOVO to add and drop courses from your initial time ticket until 11:59 PM EST on the same day.
- All students will also have access to NOVO from 11:59 PM EST on Wednesday, July 27th, until 11:59 PM on Friday, July 29th, to make changes to their schedule if desired.
- After July 29th, schedule changes must be made by your advisor.
- While identifying your time ticket, check to see if you have any registration "Holds" in NOVO. Contact your First Year Advisor if you see any "Holds."

Perfection is not expected; all that is expected is that I try my best. Notre Dame continually reinforces this mindset.

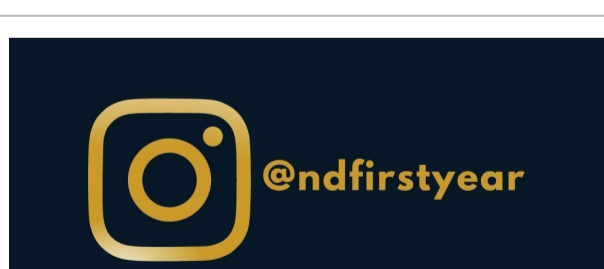
