 _ 7)	I make mnemonics for myself to help me remember facts and equations
 _8)	I make diagrams or draw mental pictures of the concepts discussed in class.
 _9)	I participate in a study group where we do homework and quiz ourselves on the material.
 _ 10)	I rework all of the quiz and test items I have missed <i>before</i> the next class session.
 _ 11)	I realize that I can still do well in this class even if I have done poorly on the quizzes and tests up to this point.
